Is there currently a government mandate shutting down production in your jurisdiction?

Effective 06/03/2020, on-set/on-location media production may operate provided they can comply with state-recommended safety guidelines, as outlined in the Open Texas Checklist for Media Production included below. The Texas Film Commission advises the following steps in preparation of all future projects:

1. Review the Checklist for Media Production
2. Register your project with the Texas Film Commission
